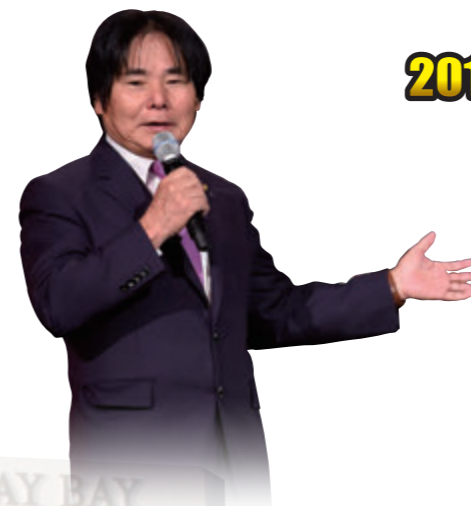
During his speech, CEO Hironari Ohshiro spoke proudly and gave encouraging words to the audience, "All who are gathered here today are the world's Kangen Water drinkers. ## 2016 Enagic Global Convention in Las Vegas



### Speech by CEO Hironari Ohshiro

Welcome to All Distributors from around the World! Let's Support Each Other and Passionately Spread the "Circle of Compassion" throughout the World!

The morning portion of the convention began with the introduction of the 6A (and above) distributors on the stage. Starting off with Australia, the distributors were introduced by their corresponding countries in alphabetical order, ending with the host country, the U.S.

Following the solo performance of the U.S. national anthem by one of the distributors, Mareyan Datan, the CEO appeared on the stage. CEO Hironari Ohshiro, who was welcomed with thunderous applause, spoke directly to all of the participants in the audience.

"The number of Enagic distributors has almost reached 1 million and the Leveluk is now used in 172 countries around the world. This is, of course, the direct result of your hard work. I am eternally grateful to all of you. Nevertheless, the world's population is estimated to be 7.5 billion, which means our journey is only just beginning."

"Enagic's 8-point program provides everyone with the opportunity to succeed in a fair manner. The program is not based on a "winner-take-all" mentality. The important thing is to help and support each other and to infuse passion into our work of spreading the compassion to the world. This effort will surely be rewarded one day."

The CEO also took to the stage during the corporation presentation held in the afternoon and explained the details of the innovative Enagic 8 Prosperity Association (E8PA). First, he touched upon his childhood experience of the cruel Battle of Okinawa during World War II. He then spoke of his homeland, Sedake, Nago, and of its importance, as it is where everything began. "I have always dreamed of providing a facility for all of you to heal your tired bodies and souls after a hard day's work. This dream is finally becoming a reality."

The E8PA program is a new system in which, after purchasing a "Facility Pass" card, the user can receive a discount or may even qualify for free use of the Enagic related facilities in Okinawa (E8PA Resort & Training Center [soon to open], Sedake Country Club, Bowl Mihama, Aroma Spa, etc.). 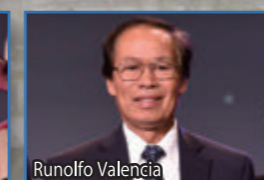

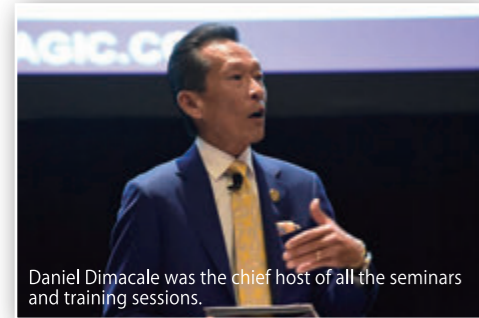
# Fulfilling Lineup of Pre-Convention Events

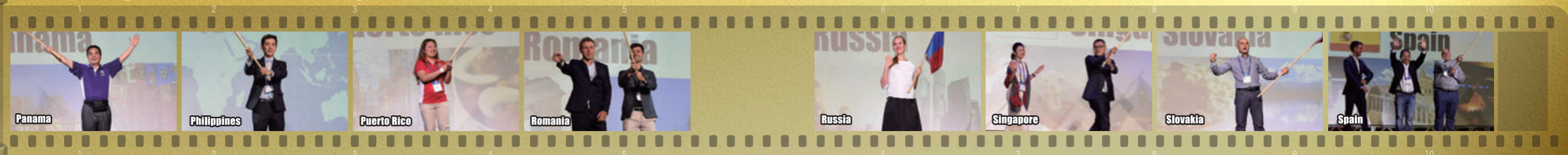
